1985-86 COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY PRIZES 150th PRIZE ESTABLISHED

This issue of <u>Poetry Pilot</u> is devoted to this year's winners in the College and University Poetry Prize Program of The Academy of American Poets. A glance at the prizes listed inside will show the variety of schools -- small and large, public and private, from all parts of the United States -- that participate in our program. 121 schools have reported in time to be listed in this special issue; the remainder will be listed in September.

This past spring, we passed a notable milestone when our 150th College Prize was established at Bradley University, in Illinois. Thirteen other schools joined our program during the course of the year: Seton Hall University, in New Jersey; Berea College, in Kentucky; Rockford College, in Illinois; Rice University, in Texas; Temple University, in Philadelphia; Valdosta State College, in Georgia; Oregon State University; Mercer University, in Georgia; Northern Michigan University; Sweet Briar College, in Virginia; Cameron University, in Oklahoma; the University of New Orleans; and Portland State University, in Oregon.

Seven of the prizes are now endowed in perpetuity: the University of Pennsylvania; Vassar College, in New York; Connecticut College; the University of Illinois, Urbana; Wells College, in New York; Wesleyan College, in Georgia; and the College of Wooster, in Ohio.
